

SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
H.P. 1943, L.D. 2022, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Funding  
of Education."

Amend the Amendment on page 9 by striking out in the 2nd  
paragraph, 11th to 17th lines the following: "and by striking  
out in the last line of paragraph B of subsection 3 the  
underlined words "are in total" and inserting in their place  
the underlined words 'are to total'; and by striking out all of  
the first underlined sentence of paragraph C of subsection 3  
and inserting in its place the following: 'The amount subtracted  
under paragraph B may not exceed 90% of the unit's entitlement  
for the base year.'" and inserting in its place the following:  
'any by striking out in subsection 3 all of paragraph B and  
inserting in its place the following: 'B. The state-local  
allocation to such a unit shall be adjusted by subtracting  
therefrom 50% of the Federal Public Law 874 receipts.'; and by  
striking out in subsection 3, paragraph C, all of the first  
underlined sentence'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this Amendment is to provide that 50% of the  
impact aid money available to any local unit will be actually  
allocated to an eligible unit.
