COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 661, L.D. 2032, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Crime of Assault on a Law Enforcement
Officer."

Amend the bill in section 2, in subsection 1, by striking
out all of paragraph A and inserting in its place the following:

'A. He intentionally, knowingly or recklessly causes
bodily injury to a law enforcement officer while the
officer is in the performance of his official duties; or'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the culpable mental state needed
to commit the crime and eliminates the requirement that bodily
injury be medically documented.
