SENATE AMENDMENT"A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A" to S.P. 658, L.D. 2035, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Specific Liability for Persons or Corporations Contributing to a Public Nuisance."

Amend the amendment in the 3rd paragraph, by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd lines and inserting in their place the following:

'an insect infestation, arising from other than normal agricultural activities, is a public nuisance and he is able to identify the source or sources of the infestation, he shall'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires that the State Entomologist refer to the Attorney General all information pertaining to an insect infestation and removes normal agricultural activities from the scope of the legislation.
