COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1959, L.D. 2041, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify the Investigation Powers of the Department
of Environmental Protection under the Oil Conveyance Program."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to Recover the Costs of Pollution Investigations.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in its place the following:

'38 MRSA §349, sub-§5, is enacted to read:

5. Recovery of costs. Any person who is found to be in violation of any provision of law administered by the Department of Environmental Protection or of any order, rule, regulation, license, permit, approval or decision of the Board of Environmental Protection or decree of the court as the case may be, is liable to the State for the reasonable costs and expenses of the State actually incurred by it in investigating and establishing the violation, to be recovered by the Attorney General for the account from which the moneys were expended, in an action brought in the name of the State.

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the State may recover actual costs of investigating and establishing that a violation of state law has occurred.
