COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1960, L.D. 2043, RESOLVE,
Authorizing the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands to Lease
the Right to Lay and Maintain a Certain Right-of-way for Forty
Years.

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency
preamble.

Further amend the ^{resolve} / by striking out all of the last
sentence before the emergency clause and inserting in its place
the following:

'The right is to be leased upon such terms and conditions
as are negotiated by the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands.'

Further amend the / by striking out all of the emergency
clause.

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are:

1. To strike out the emergency provision which would make
this bill unconstitutional, as an emergency land transfer
is unconstitutional; and
2. To clarify other language in the bill.
