COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1976, L.D. 2059, Bill,  
 "AN ACT to Correct the Inequitable Taxation of Mobile and  
 Modular Homes."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1 and  
 renumbering section 2 to be section 1.

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after section  
 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be  
 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes  
 of this Act:

Fiscal Note

This bill is not an emergency so<sup>an</sup> appropriation is only  
 needed in the 1978-79 fiscal year. Further, enactment of this  
 bill will result in a decrease in revenue in the amount of \$537,600  
 for the fiscal year 1978-79. Ninety-six percent of the loss  
 would be attributable to the General Fund and 4% to the Local  
 Government Fund.

Statement of Fact

This amendment eliminates from the bill any changes in the excise tax to which a mobile home is presently subject and corrects the appropriation needed and the fiscal note to reflect that if enacted the bill will not become effective until fiscal year 1978-79.
