HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1980, L.D. 2072, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Municipal Boundary between the Town of
Old Orchard Beach and the City of Saco."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "Sec. 1." of section
and 20th
1 by striking out in the 17th, 18th/ lines (11th, 12th, 13th and 14th
lines in L.D.) the underlined figure "1,000" and inserting
in their place the underlined figure '500'

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the distances
provided in the bill from 1,000 feet to 500 feet in accordance
with an agreement between the municipalities of Saco and
Old Orchard Beach.
