HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.  
1998, L.D. 2079, Bill "AN ACT to Establish Standards to Protect Maine  
Consumers Against Unsafe and Improperly Manufactured Cellulose  
Fiber Insulation."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the title the  
following:

'Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the  
first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation,  
figure and punctuation 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out in the first line  
the word "Amend" and inserting in its place the words 'Further  
amend'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting at the end before  
the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before  
the emergency clause the following:

Sec. 2. Transition. Notwithstanding the provisions of  
Title 25, section 2447-A, any cellulose fiber insulation sold or  
offered for sale within a 45-day period following the effective  
date of this Act may be exempt from any labeling requirements  
provided under this Act.'
