HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1999,  
L.D. 2080, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Trafficking in Five Pounds or  
More of Marijuana a Class C Crime under the Maine Criminal Code."

Amend the amendment in section 1, paragraph D, by striking  
out in the 2nd line the following: "2 pounds or less" and inserting  
in its place the following: '4 pounds or less'

Further amend the amendment in section 2, in paragraph B,  
by striking out in the 2nd line the following: "more than 2  
pounds;" and inserting in its place the following: 'more than 4  
pounds;'

Further amend the amendment in the last line before the  
statement of fact by striking out the figure "2" and inserting  
in its place the following: '4'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to raise the amount of  
marijuana that is necessary to raise a presumption of trafficking  
from 2 pounds to 4 pounds.
