SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
2007, L.D. 2084, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Inspection of
Dams."

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated
"§813." by striking out in the 5th line the underlined words
"State Treasury" and inserting in their place the underlined
words 'Department of Agriculture'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the
statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before
the statement of fact the following new section:

Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds shall be
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act:

Soil & Water Conservation Commission	\$10,000'

Fiscal Note

This appropriation provides funds to pay for the
inspections. In the case of a dam or reservoir being judged unsafe
or insufficient, the State will recover the cost of the in-
spection.
