SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2007, L.D. 2084, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Inspection of Dams."

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "<u>\$813.</u>" by striking out in the 5th line the underlined words "<u>State Treasury</u>" and inserting in their place the underlined words '<u>Department of Agriculture</u>'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following new section:

Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act:
