COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 2036, L.D. 2100,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Sale of Electricity to  
Public Utilities."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the last  
underlined sentence before the statement of fact and inserting  
in its place the following:

'The Public Utilities Commission may determine such rates  
and other conditions as shall safeguard the rights and  
interests of both the generating corporation and the public  
utility.'

Statement of Fact

This change permits the Public Utilities Commission  
to consider factors such as power availability, reliability  
and other aspects that may affect rates.
