COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2042, L.D. 2107, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Residents of the Islands in Casco Bay with Additional Transportation Service."

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Any vessel carrying 6 or less passengers for compensation may transport passengers between the islands or between the mainland and these islands designated in this section during the period after 30 minutes following the last scheduled departure of the day and 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled departure on the following day of an authorized vessel carrying 7 or more passengers for compensation from the mainland to these islands and from these islands to the mainland.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the operation of vessels transporting 6 or less passengers for compensation to the period when Casco Bay Lines has completed all of its scheduled service for the day. According to this amendment, vessels transporting 6 or less passengers for compensation will operate only during the period following the departure of the last vessel of Casco Bay Lines for the day and before the operation of the first vessel of Casco Bay Lines on the following day.
