HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to H.P. 2051, L.D. 2111, Bill,
"AN ACT to Establish and Apply a Policy on the Classification
of Major Policy-influencing Positions Below the Head of State
Department and Agencies."

Amend the Bill in section 12 by striking out all of the
2nd underlined sentence of that part designated "§1951."
and inserting in its place the following:

'The commissioner shall appoint, to serve at his pleasure,
a Deputy Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife who
shall be qualified by training and experience in fisheries
and wildlife management and conservation law enforcement.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of sections
23 and 25.

Further amend the Bill by renumbering/^{the}sections of the
Bill to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

This amendment establishes qualifications for the Deputy
Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and deletes
sections of the bill which permit the Commissioner of Public
Safety to remove the State Fire Marshal at his pleasure and which
unclassify the Executive Secretary of the Governor's Committee
on Employment of the Handicapped.
