SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 2051, L.D. 2111, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Establish and Apply a Policy on the Classification  
of Major Policy-influencing Positions Below the Head of State

Amend the ~~Bill~~ in section 12 by striking out all of the  
2nd underlined sentence of that part designated "§1951."  
and inserting in its place the following:

'The commissioner shall appoint, to serve at his pleasure, a  
Deputy Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife who shall  
be qualified by training and experience in fisheries and wildlife  
management and conservation law enforcement.'
