COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 2057, L.D. 2115, Bill, "AN ACT to Improve Property Tax Statutes."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1 and by renumbering section 2 to be section 1.

Further amend the Bill by inserting before section 3 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act:
