COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2066, L.D. 2129, Bill,
"AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Lincolnville to Withdraw
from the Appleton-Hope-Lincolnville Community School District."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the
emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 13. Computation of state-local allocations. The
Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services is authorized
to prorate expenditures made by the Appleton-Hope-Lincolnville
Community School District for the purpose of determining state-
local allocations for the Town of Lincolnville and the Appleton-
Hope Community School District.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize the
commissioner to prorate the expenditures of the community
school district for the next 2 years in order to determine
the state-local allocations for Lincolnville and for the
community school district.
