SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 2072, L.D. 2131, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Provide for the Payment of Costs for Relocating  
Utility Facilities in an Urban Renewal Area."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§4882." by striking  
out all of the last underlined sentence of paragraph B of  
subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'In the event that federal moneys are not available to refund  
a public utility for relocating its facilities as described  
in this section, after the exercise of due diligence by the  
authority to obtain the same, the Public Utilities Commission  
is authorized to consider any reasonable unrecovered costs  
of relocation as property devoted to public use for  
rate-making purposes, / <sup>within</sup> the meaning of Title 35, section  
52.

C. When a utility's relocation costs from a development plan  
are estimated to exceed \$50,000, the public utility shall  
so inform the Public Utilities Commission and shall furnish  
the information that may be required to keep the commission  
appraised of the development plan and progress being made  
in obtaining federal moneys to reimburse the utility for  
relocating its facilities. The administering authority  
shall make available to the public utility the information  
that it has concerning federal reimbursement of the relocation

cost so that the utility may keep the Public Utilities Commission informed.'
