COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2079, L.D. 2133, Bill, "AN ACT to Transfer the Division of Motor Vehicles to the Department of Transportation."

← Amend the bill in section 20 by inserting at the end the following new sentences:

'The person who, on December 31, 1978, is incumbent in the Deputy Secretary of State position shall be considered appointed under the Personnel Law to the position on January 1, 1979, without having to satisfy any other requirement. The person may retain his appointment subject to the Personnel Law until January 1, 1983.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits the Deputy Secretary of State in charge of the Motor Vehicle Division on December 31, 1978, to be considered a classified employee until January 1, 1983.
