HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 695,
L.D. 2136, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish the Health Facilities
Information Disclosure Act."

Amend the Amendment in section 1 in that part designated
"§364." by adding at the end the following:

'7. State anti-trust exemption. Any voluntary budget
review organization approved by the board and any hospital
submitting information to such an organization shall be exempt
from Title 10, section 1101, et seq. and Title 5, section 207,
et seq. for its reporting and budget review activities conducted
pursuant to this section and section 352, subsection 8.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a state
anti-trust exemption under the bill which was contained in
Committee Amendment B.
