Further amend the Amendment on page 6 in that part
designated "§357." by striking out all of subsection 2 and
renumbering subsections 3 to 5 to be subsections 2 to 4.

Further amend the Amendment on page 7 in that part
designated "§357." by renumbering subsection 6 to be subsection
5 and by striking out all of subsections 7 and 8.

Further amend the Amendment on page 9 in subsection 7
by striking out all of the first underlined sentence and
inserting in its place the following: 'To the extent feasible,
the board in establishing uniform systems shall take into account
the data requirements of relevant reimbursement programs.'

Further amend the Amendment on pages 10 and 10-A by
striking out all of that part designated "§359."

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of that
part designated "§364."

Further amend the Amendment in section 1 by renumbering
sections
those / designated "\$360." to "\$369." to be sections "\$359."
to "\$367."

Further amend the Amendment in section 2 by striking out
all of the 7th and 8th lines and inserting in their place the
following:

'All Other	<u>10,000</u>
	\$50,000'
