Amend the Amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the first underlined paragraph.

Further amend the Amendment on page 3 by striking out all of subsection 8.

Further amend the Amendment on page 6 in that part designated "§357." by striking out all of subsection 2 and renumbering subsections 3 to 5 to be subsections 2 to 4.

Further amend the Amendment on page 7 in that part designated "<u>\$357.</u>" by renumbering subsection 6 to be subsection 5 and by striking out all of subsections 7 and 8.

Further amend the Amendment on page 9 in subsection 7 by striking out all of the first underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following: 'To the extent feasible, the board in establishing uniform systems shall take into account the data requirements of relevant reimbursement programs.'

Further amend the Amendment on pages 10 and 10-A by striking out all of that part designated "\$359."

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of that part designated "§364."

Further amend the Amendment in section 1 by renumbering sections those / designated "<u>\$360.</u>" to "<u>\$369.</u>" to be sections "<u>\$359.</u>" to "\$367."

'All Other
