HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2101, L.D. 2140, RESOLVE,  
Authorizing Certain Employees of the State of Maine to Request  
an Extension of Employment After Their Mandatory Retirement  
Age, Years of Service Requirements or Age and Years of Service  
Requirement.

Amend the Resolve by striking out all of the 8th paragraph  
and inserting in its place the following:

'Extension of mandatory retirement age. Resolved: That  
any state employee who is subject to mandatory retirement at  
a specified age, years of service requirement, or any age and  
years of service requirement as provided in the Revised Statutes,  
Title 5, section 1121, from the period of January 1, 1978,  
through June 30, 1978, may request an extension of service as  
provided in the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1121,  
subsection 1, paragraph B; and be it further'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the intent  
of the resolve by deleting the last sentence of the 8th paragraph.
