HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2102, L.D. 2140, RESOLVE,  
Authorizing Certain Employees of the State of Maine to Request  
an Extension of Employment After Their Mandatory Retirement  
Age, Years of Service Requirements or Age and Years of Service  
Requirement.

Amend the Resolve by striking out all of the 8th and 9th  
paragraphs and inserting in their place the following:

'Extension of mandatory retirement age. Resolved: That  
any state employee who is subject to mandatory retirement at  
a specified age, years of service requirement, or any age and  
years of service requirement as provided in the Revised Statutes,  
Title 5, section 1121, from the period of January 1, 1978,  
through June 30, 1978, may request an extension of service as  
provided in the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1121,  
subsection 1, paragraph B. That request shall not be denied  
arbitrarily or on the basis of age, length of service or age and  
length of service; and be it further

Resolved: That any state employee who has retired subsequent  
to January 1, 1978, and prior to enactment of this resolve may  
request an extension of service as provided in / <sup>this resolve.</sup> If that  
request for extension of service is approved and the employee  
is subsequently reemployed, that employee shall not be deemed  
retired but shall be considered in a leave of absence without  
pay status from the date at which he would have retired to the  
date of his reemployment. If any retirement benefits have been  
received during that period, the Maine State Retirement System

shall recompute the retirement benefits of the effected individual. '

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the intent of the resolve.
