COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2110, L.D. 2143, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require the Judicial Department to Reimburse Counties
Quarterly for the Expenses of Bailiffs and Other Court and Jury
Officers."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§25." by inserting at the end of the first underlined paragraph
the following underlined sentence:

'The reimbursement shall be for the number of officers requested
to serve the court in that county by the Judicial Department, prov-
vided that the Judicial Department shall consult with the sheriff
in each county as to the level of security which is necessary.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the
following:

'Sec. 4. Effective date. This Act shall become effective
on January 1, 1979.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency
clause.

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the bill to insure that the courts
are only required to reimburse the counties for court officers
for the number of officers requested by the courts. This amend-
ment also removes the emergency from the bill.
