HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 2132, L.D. 2157, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Administration and Toll System of the Maine Turnpike."

Amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "§331." subsection 2, by inserting in the last sentence, after the underlined words "intersecting roadways" the following:
',not to exceed 1/4 mile,'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to provide a standard for determining sufficient lengths of roadways. Under the provisions of the bill, sufficient lengths of roadways could be construed to permit the construction or reconstruction of several miles of intersecting roadways that intersect with the Maine Turnpike. Since intersecting roadways lie outside the turnpike, construction or reconstruction of these roadways with toll revenues should be limited.
