HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 2132, L.D. 2157, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Administration and Toll System of the Maine
Turnpike."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"§337." by striking out all of subsection 4 and by renumbering
subsections 5 and 6 to be subsections 4 and 5.

Statement of Fact

The intent of this Amendment is to prohibit the use of toll
revenues for the construction of interconnecting access roads.
According to the bill, turnpike toll revenues can be used to
reconstruct, construct and maintain interconnecting access roads
for a distance of 10 miles from the turnpike.
