HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 2132, L.D. 2157, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Administration and Toll System of the Maine Turnpike."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§335." of section 2 by striking out all of the last 2 sentences of subsection 1 and inserting in their place the following:

'At least one year prior to the conversion of the turnpike to a toll barrier system, the Commissioner of Transportation shall present the recommendation to the Legislature during the first week of January for the Legislature's approval, rejection or change during that legislative session. In the event that the Legislature does not make a decision within that legislative session, the recommendation of the Commissioner of Transportation for the location of toll barriers shall be authorized.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the Legislature has the entire session, instead of 40 days, to consider toll barrier placement.
