SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 2132, L.D. 2157, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Administration and Toll System of the
Maine Turnpike."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated "§335."
by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its
place the following:

'1. Three barrier system. Upon the conversion of the
Maine Turnpike to a barrier toll system, there shall be only
3 toll barriers upon the Maine Turnpike, which shall be located
as follows:

A. At Kittery;

B. At Augusta; and

C. At a location between the location of Exits 8 and
9 as they existed on January 1, 1978.'


Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"§335." by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting
in its place the following:

'2. Removal of unneeded toll facilities. The department
shall, when sufficient funds are available, convert the Maine
Turnpike to a barrier toll system and remove the existing
toll collection facilities not needed for barrier toll
facilities.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the present subsection 1 of section 335 from the bill and inserts a new subsection 1 of section 335 which provides that, upon conversion of the Maine Turnpike to a toll barrier system, there shall be only 3 toll barriers, located in Kittery, Augusta and between exists 8 and 9.
