
SENATE AMENDMENT B "to H.P. 2132, L.D. 2157, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Revise the Administration and Toll System of the Maine Turnpike."

Amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "§336."  
by striking out all of the first sentence and inserting in its  
place the following:

'The rate of toll at each facility shall be fixed and revised  
from time to time upon recommendation of the Commissioner of  
Transportation, subject to approval by the Legislature during the  
January prior to the revision. '

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the Legislature must approve  
any future changes in tolls on recommendation of the Commissioner  
of Transportation.
