
SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 2132, L.D. 2157, Bill, "AN ACT
to Revise the Administration and Toll System of the Maine Turnpike."

Amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "§336."
by striking out all of the first sentence and inserting in its
place the following:

'The rate of toll at each facility shall be fixed and revised
from time to time upon recommendation of the Commissioner of
Transportation. The commissioner shall present the recommendation
to the Legislature during the first week of January for the
Legislature's approval, rejection or change during that legis-
lative session. In the event that the Legislature does not make
a decision within that legislative session, the recommendation
of the Commissioner ←————→ for the rate of toll at each
facility shall be authorized.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the Legislature must approve
any future changes in tolls on recommendation of the Commissioner
of Transportation.
