ACT to Amend the Maine Juvenile Code."

Amend the bill in section 41 in the 5th line (4th in L.D.)
of paragraph A by striking out the underlined figure "19th"
and inserting in its place the underlined figure '18th'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that committment shall be for an
indeterminate period not to extend beyond the juvenile's 18th,
rather than 19th, birthday, unless the court expressly limits
or extends the committment.
