SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 2142, L.D. 2163, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Amend the Maine Juvenile Code."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph  
of section 41 and inserting in its place the following:

'A. A commitment of a juvenile to the Department of Mental  
Health and Corrections, including a commitment to the Maine  
Youth Center, pursuant to section 3314 shall be for an indeterminate  
period not to extend beyond the juvenile's ~~21st~~ 19th birthday  
unless the court expressly further ~~limits~~ extends the  
commitment, provided that no commitment shall extend beyond  
a juvenile's 21st birthday.'

Statement of Fact

A juvenile committed to the Maine Youth Center may be  
committed only for an indeterminate time not to exceed  
his 19th or 21st birthday.
