HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2183, L.D. 2175, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Bond Issue in the Amount of \$2,100,000 to Establish a Dormitory at Northern Maine Vocational-Technical Institute."

Amend the bill by striking out the Title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Authorize a Self-liquidating Bond Issue in the Amount of \$2,100,000 to Establish a Dormitory at Northern Maine Vocational-Technical Institute.'

Further amend the bill in the 3rd paragraph from the end before the statement of fact, by inserting after the word "Authorize" the following 'a Self-liquidating'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes it clear in the referendum question and in the Title of the Act that the bond issue is self-liquidating.
