HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 2184, L.D. 2176, Bill, "AN ACT to Empower the Oil Burner Men's Licensing Board to Inspect and Approve Coal and Wood Fuel Central Heating Equipment."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the amending clause of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §2301, sub-§5 is enacted to read:'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the amending clause of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §2301-A is enacted to read:'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the first underlined sentence of that part designated "§2301-A." of section 3 and inserting in its place the following: $\frac{NO}{COAl}$ or wood central heating equipment shall be sold or offered for sale in this State unless the equipment is approved by the Oil Burner Men's Licensing Board.' HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2184, L.D. 2176

Statement of Fact

This amendment leaves the existing law with respect to oil burning equipment unchanged and adds new provisions dealing solely with the approval of coal and wood central heating equipment.
