STATE OF MAINE SENATE 108TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 732, L.D. 2177, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Postgraduate Education in the Field of Medicine, Dentistry, Optometry and Veterinary Medicine."

Amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "§2272" by inserting at the end the following:

'5. Clinical education site. For purposes of this

chapter, "clinical education site" includes both clinical

clerkship sites and preceptorship sites. "Clinical clerkship

site" means an on-location teaching environment in conjunction

with residency training. "Preceptorship site" means any site

ranging from a one-to-one training site between a physician

and medical student to a training site in a health clinic or

hospital without a residency program.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§2273." in subsection 1 by striking out in the first sentence the year "1976" and inserting in its place the following: '1977'

The purpose of this amendment is to correct an error in the year. It also clarifies the definition of clinical education site.
