HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 2215, L.D. 2183, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Reform of the State Tax Laws."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Appropriate Surplus Funds to the Maine State Retirement System and Treasury Department for Retirement of Bonded Indebtedness.

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act:

TREASURY, DEPARTMENT OF

All Other \$6,500,000
