STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 108TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A"to H. P. 2229, L.D. 2189, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Maine Sunset Law and State Agency Rules Law."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §505, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 554, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§505. Analysis and recommendations by the Joint Standing Committee on Performance Audit

1. Objectives. For each department and independent agency which has submitted a justification report, the Joint Standing Committee on Performance Audit shall evaluate the analysis in the report and may conduct its own analysis which shall include, but shall not be limited to, an analysis of the extent to which the objectives of the department or independent agency have been reached. The Legislative Finance Office shall provide the Joint Standing <u>on Performance Audit</u> Committee/with whatever assistance is requested for the purposes of this subsection.

2. Submittal of analyses. The Joint Standing Committee on Performance Audit (shall submit to the Legislature the evaluations and analyses prepared pursuant to this section of the departments and independent agencies listed in section 507 and its recommendations and any legislation required to implement them according to the following schedule: COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A"H.P. 2229, L.D. 2189

Group A, no later than October 31, 1979; Group B, no later than October 31, 1981; Group C, no later than October 31, 1983; Group D, no later than October 31, 1985; and Group E, no later than October 31, 1987.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the Joint Standing Committee on Performance Audit will perform the review and analyses required by the Act being recommended by L. D. 2189.
