HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 2232, L.D. 2190, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Place of Filing Under the Uniform Commercial Code."

Amend the Bill in section 3 by inserting after the next to the last sentence of subsection 1 the following:

'If a municipal clerk received Uniform Commercial Code payments, he shall be entitled to reimbursement under this section. In the event subsequent actions have increased the payments because of the Uniform Commercial Code, the municipal officers shall determine what proportion, ^{if any} shall be paid to their respective municipal clerk.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify provisions for reimbursement to the town clerks.
