HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 2232, L.D. 2190, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to the Place of Filing Under the Uniform Commercial
Code."

Amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out all of the last
paragraph of subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'No municipality shall receive any moneys under this subsection
unless and until the municipal clerk shall have filed with the
Treasurer of State a certified audit or a sworn notarized
statement of the filing fees received during the 1976 calendar
year.'
