HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 748, L.D. 2199, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the Emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 371. ~~←~~20 MRSA §2454, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 289, is amended to read:

§2454. School administrative unit fee during school year

A school administrative unit may charge a fee, based on the per pupil cost, for a driver education course conducted after regular school hours during the school year, provided there is no licensed commercial instructor available within a reasonable distance from his domicile.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prohibit economic interference with private commercial driving schools licensed by the State.
