HOUSE AMENDMENT "R" to S. P. 748, L.D. 2199, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 371. 32 MRSA §1871, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 381, §2, amended by as reallocated, is / inserting at the end the following new sentence:

'The department shall have the authority to establish regulations governing local redemption centers which receive beverage containers from dealers supplied by distributors other than the distributors servicing the area in which the local redemption center is located in order to prevent the distributors servicing the area within which the redemption center is located from being unfairly penalized.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits the Department of Agriculture to establish rules to deal with a problem which has developed with redemption centers.
