" AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies
in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill in section 365 by striking out all of the
underlined
last/sentence and inserting in its place the following:

Subsequent terms of office shall be fixed at 7 years and each
term shall expire on May 15th of the appropriate year,
except that a member shall continue to serve until a successor
trustee has been appointed and qualified to assume office, or until
January 15th following the expiration date, whichever shall occur first.
