
SENATE AMENDMENT " C " to S. P. 748, L.D. 2199, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 371. 16 MRSA §355, last sentence is amended to read:
When the plaintiff is a corporation, the affidavit may be made by its president, vice president, secretary or treasurer.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows the vice president of a corporation to sign an affidavit to prove an account against a debtor in District Court.
