SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 752, L.D. 2203, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify the Collective Bargaining Laws for Teachers
and to Establish a Commission to Study the Problems Relating
Thereeto."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting
in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Insure Local Control
Over Education Policy.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and before the emergency preamble and inserting in
its place the following:

'20 MRSA §161, first ¶, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 580,
§17, is further amended by inserting after the 4th sentence,
the following:

Just cause for dismissal or nonrenewal shall not be subject to
interest arbitration under Title 26, section 965, subsection 4, from
July 1, 1978 to June 30, 1980.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment establishes a moratorium from July 1, 1978, to
June 30, 1980, on just cause provisions being inserted into
teacher contracts as a result of interest arbitration.
