SENATE AMENDMENT "C " to S.P. 752, L.D. 2203 $\leftarrow \rightarrow \rightarrow$, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Collective Bargaining Laws for Teachers and to Establish a Commission to Study the Problems Relating Thereto."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Insure Local Control Over Education Policy.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

¹<u>Sec. 1. 20 MRSA §161, sub-§5, 4th sentence</u>, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 723, §2, is repealed as follows: dust-cause-for-dismissal-or-nonrenewal-may-be-a-negotiable-item in-accordance-with-the-procedure-set-forth-in-Title-267-cr-9-A7 for-teachers-who-have-served-beyond-the-probationary-period.

Sec. 2. 20 MRSA \$161, sub-\$5, first ¶, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 580, \$17, is further amended by inserting at the end the following:

The board shall record the hearing in a form susceptible to transcription and shall transcribe the recording when review of the board's decision by the Superior Court is sought in accordance with this section. A teacher whose continuing contract is not renewed under this subsection may, after the hearing provided herein, seek review by the Superior Court under Rule 80B of the Maine Rules of Civil Procedure. The review shall be confined to a determinati of whether the decision of the school committee was arbitrary and capricious. The Superior Court shall complete its review Jr.

within 60 days after the request for review under Rule 80B is made.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes from the statutes a provision which states that just cause may be a negotiable item, provides that a board hearing on a teacher contract nonrenewal shall be transcribed if needed and requires the Superior Court to complete its review of this type of hearing within 60 days after the board's decision not to renew.
