SENATE AMENDMENT"A" to S.P. 760, L.D. 2205, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Necessary Corrections in the Knox County and Lincoln County Budget, the Errors and Inconsistencies Act and the Administrative Procedure Act."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 3-A.32 MRSA §2955 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§2955. Refusal and revocation

The commissioner shall have the right to refuse or revoke a license pursuant to Title 5, section 10004 when the applicant or licensee has been convicted of a crime for which the maximum term of imprisonment which may be imposed is one year or more or when the applicant or licensee has been convicted of fraudulent or deceptive practices.

Sec. 3-B. Effective date. Section 3-A of this Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct a conflict between L.D. 1969 and L.D. 2145 both of which repeal and replace Title 32, section 2955.
