HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S. P. 772,
L.D. 2209, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution
to Limit the Amount of Government Spending and Taxes which
may be Made without Voter Approval.

Amend the Amendment on page 2 by striking out all of sub-
section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Protection of local government from state required
costs. The legislative and executive departments are prohibited
from requiring that other levels of government provide services
without state or federal shared financing.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prohibit the mandate
of present or future state programs unless the State pays
the full financial burden.
