House Amendment "L" to S.P. 772, L.D. 2209, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Limit the Amount of Government Spending and Taxes which may be Made without Voter Approval.

Amend the resolution by striking out all of $sub-\P\P$ (7), and (8) of paragraph A of subsection 6 of section 22 of Art. I of the Constitution as enacted by this resolution, and insert in its place the following:

- '(7) The balances of funds established pursuant to subsections 2 and 3;
- (8) Allocations of revenues received pursuant to
 Article IX, section 19; and
- (9) All expenditures from state dedicated revenue accounts that are dedicated prior to January 1, 1979.

Further amend the resolution by striking out the last 3 paragraphs before the "Constitutional referendum procedure."

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the provisions of L.D. 2209 in respect to dedicated revenue accounts.

The amendment excludes all dedicated revenue accounts that

are dedicated prior to January 1, 1979, and removes ambiguous language under Art. IX, section 19, subsections 1 and 2, relating to the Highway Fund from the bill.
