SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 772, L.D. 2209, RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Limit the Amount
of Government Spending and Taxes which may be Made without Voter
Approval.

Amend the Resolution in the 5th paragraph by striking out
all of the first two underlined sentences and inserting in their
place the following:

'The State and local units of government / ^{are} authorized to _
establish a Special Reserve Fund to which may be appropriated
annually an amount equal to one percent of the limit as
determined in subsection 1. An appropriation from the
Special Reserve Fund may be made for any purpose upon a two-
thirds vote of the governing body.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish a special
reserve fund for local units of government.
